

LORETTA MUELLER SEMINAR
Tuesday, September 18 – Thursday, September 20, 2018

Tuesday and Wednesday will be full-day sessions. Thursday will be broken up into two half-day sessions. Each session will have up to 10 working spots and up to 10 auditors. If you are interested in a working spot or an audit spot for any of these sessions, please fill out the following application. ***Please get your applications in by February 1, 2018***, since I will start assigning working spots during early February. After working spots and audit spots have been agreed upon, I will ask for payment. Each full-day working spot will cost \$200. Each full-day audit spot will cost \$50. Each half-day working spot costs \$100. Each half-day audit spot costs \$25.

Your total payment must be received by April 1, 2018, to reserve your working spots. If your total payment has not been received by then, and there is a wait list for any of your working spots, I will then invite the next person on the wait list to fill those working spots. Your total payment for audit spots is due by September 11, 2018.

There will be no refunds for any reason after payment is made, but working spots may be transferred to another qualified candidate ***as long as that candidate is approved by me first.***

SEMINAR SESSIONS: (This schedule could change depending on applications received)

Tuesday, September 18, 2018

8:30 AM – 5:15 PM: Master Handling I – This session will focus on a variety of handling and training issues encountered in today's courses. This session may include AKC Premier and USDAA Masters Challenge type sequences. Dogs should be able to handle Master level courses and should be familiar with common international elements. There will be a 45-minute lunch break near the middle of this session.

Wednesday, September 19, 2018

8:30 AM – 5:15 PM: Master Handling II – This session will focus on a variety of handling and training issues encountered in today's courses using different sequences and/or courses than used in Master Handling I. This session may include AKC Premier and USDAA Masters Challenge type sequences. Dogs should be able to handle Master level courses and should be familiar with common international elements. There will be a 45-minute lunch break near the middle of this session.

Thursday, September 20, 2018

8:30 AM – 12:30 PM: Foundation Skills for Young Dogs – This session will focus on foundation skills for young dogs that are just beginning their agility careers. Dogs should be at least 6 months old to participate. Dogs participating must be able to work in a group with reasonable focus. Dogs should be familiar with jumps and tunnels, although dogs need not be jumping any significant height. Bars set on the ground or simply going between wings will be fine for the younger participants.

1:15 PM – 5:15 PM: Novice and Open Handling – This session will focus on building skills for dogs currently trialing at the AKC Novice/USDAA Starters and/or AKC Open/USDAA Advanced levels. Dogs should be familiar with all agility equipment and should be currently trialing at AKC Novice/Open levels and/or USDAA Starters/Advanced levels.
